

# **Melbourne's New Free Tram Zone**

Applies to tram travel only. If you're only travelling in the Free Tram Zone, your journey is free and you don't need a Myki. If you accidentally touch on, you'll be charged a 2 hour Zone 1+2 fare. For more information, see the Fares and Ticketing Manual. If you start or finish your journey outside the Free Tram Zone you need to pay for your journey and use a Myki.



### Zone 1+2

Applies to train, tram and bus travel.

Travel entirely within Zone 1.

Travel between the Free Tram Zone, Zone 1 and Zone 2.

Travel between Zone 1 and Zone 2.

Zone 2 only

Applies to train, tram and bus travel.

Travel entirely within Zone 2.

Travel entirely within the Zone 1/2 boundary overlap.

Travel to Zone 1/2 boundary overlap from Zone 2.

### **MYKI MONEY**

If you travel occasionally, pay as you go with myki Money. Load a dollar amount onto your Myki and your myki will automatically calculate the lowest fare possible as you touch on and touch off.
